


Amplifying hope, transforming lives.

Life plan program is about offering vulnerable young adults the courage and tools to rewrite their stories — stories too often shaped by adversity—with hope, resilience, and opportunity.

For young people left behind by the system, this program offers more than just support; it provides a lifeline, a path to independence and a chance to redefine what their futures can hold.

Since 2020, we've walked alongside 61 young adults, helping them shatter the chains of poverty, stigma and exclusion. These are not just numbers; they are lives transformed, futures reclaimed and a testament to what is possible when we choose to invest in hope.







VALENTIN ALI

Dreams enabled

Before

Valentin entered the child protection system at the age of 2 with his sister, Geanina. Raised by a foster carer until 15, he later moved to a care home, where he struggled with managing money. Passionate about hairdressing, music, and art, he hoped the program would help him grow and achieve his dream.





Valentin has proven to be a highly motivated individual, the project helpd him become financially independent and responsible. During the program, he found a job as a children's party entertainer, a role he enjoyed immensely. Inspired by this experience, he decided to take a step further and start his own event planning business focused on organizing children's parties. Currently, Valentin is working in his own company. Realizing that having a car would make it easier to travel to events, they decided to purchase one together. To support this new need, Valentin obtained his driver's license, allowing him to handle transportation and further expand their business capabilities.




LAURA STOICA

Breaking barriers

Before

Homeless after leaving foster care, Laura struggled to find stability, facing rejection in both personal and professional settings.



Now

Life Plan project has significantly transformed Laura's life. When she joined, she was homeless, but now she has a rented home and a stable job she enjoys, with strong relationships with her colleagues. She actively participates in the association's activities and is a Life Plan ambassador, inspiring others. Recently, she fulfilled her dream of pursuing a career in coffee by completing a Barista training course, boosting her confidence and motivation. While she has made remarkable progress, we hope to encourage her to take her baccalaureate exam to further her education and open new career opportunities.



ELENA ASAN

Rising Strong

Before

Elena entered the child protection system at 6 due to her family's financial struggles. After a brief return home, she re-entered the system at 10 and remains there. At 14, martial arts trainers became pivotal in her growth, offering support and guidance. Turning 18 brought maturity and responsibility, fueling her dream to become the best martial arts trainer.





is another success story. She is a determined, disciplined and hardworking young woman who achieved full independence after completing the program. While she occasionally needed support to participate in sports competitions and navigate personal and professional challenges, she has consistently demonstrated resilience. Recently, she was rehired by **Decathlon**, where her previous reliability as an employee made her a valuable addition to the team. Elena is a capable individual who sets and achieves her goals, manages her budget effectively and knows when to seek guidance when needed.



George Fixon

Hope beyond Hardship

Before

George's childhood was not a friendly one. Raised by relatives in hardship, George entered a children's home at 13 due to financial struggles. Though he knows his parents, he stays in touch only with his mother, who works abroad to support him. Life in the institution provided stability but lacked the emotional support and intimacy essential for his growth.








After joining the program, George initially struggled with gambling, but his openness about the issue allowed him to receive **targeted help, including addiction counseling**. Within just three months, he made remarkable progress, managing his finances independently by paying rent from his earnings and saving additional funds. Now, George is focused on building a stable and independent future, guided by his values of family, responsibility, and a desire to make a positive impact as a medical assistant.

IULIU MOLDOVAN

Embracing passion

Before

Raised in foster care, he faced financial instability and emotional challenges after leaving the system.



Now



After completing the project, Iulian reconnected with a partner employer and secured a chef position. She rehired him and provided temporary housing until he found his own place. With our continued support, he pursued his dream of performing, including sponsored singing lessons that earned him a popularity award at an event organized by fellow participant Anton Bangaci. We remain by Iulian's side, eagerly awaiting the day he graces Romania's biggest stages.

MIHAI DUMITRU

Overcoming the odds

Before

Raised in multiple care facilities after being abandoned by his alcoholic parents, Mihai faced severe instability.






Mihai left the project after just one year and moved to the Netherlands to save money opening a barbershop. A highly determined individual, he took on three jobs and quickly managed to gather the necessary funds. He returned to his hometown in Romania, where he has been running his own barbershop for over two **years.** With a growing client base and great success, he has even been able to hire employees to help expand his business, showcasing his drive and entrepreneurial spirit.







Rewriting futures. Shaping society.

These are just a glimpse into the lives transformed by Life Plan. Each story represents not only a changed individual but a ripple effect of hope and opportunity that touches families, friends and communities. When we lift one life, we begin to shift the trajectory of society itself, building a future rooted in compassion, resilience and possibility.



61 lives changed, providing tools for independence and stability.

- 1408 individual sessions of social assistance and psycho-emotional support.
- 1154 psychological counseling sessions, helping participants heal and grow.
- 261 vocational counseling sessions, guiding participants to sustainable careers.
- 178 job market mediations.
- 199 educational counseling sessions, financial counseling sessions and coaching sessions.
- 111 workshops: emotion management, relationship building, skill development, self-awareness.
- 33 company visits, building life skills and confidence.
- 30 young adults remain engaged as ambassadors.

How we address them

Emotional and financial support

Provided emotional and financial support to help young people overcome difficult situations such as marginalization, adaptation to current context, conflicts, independence issues and medical problems.

Educational assistance

Facilitated tutoring sessions to help young people prepare for the Baccalaureate exam, and supported them in completing and continuing their formal studies, such as hairdressing, driving license, hospitality, etc.

Housing

Offering the stability of a safe home and enviorment, without the risk of homelessness so they can focus on their developlement.



How we address them

Life skills workshops

We conduct practical workshops on topics like financial literacy, cooking, maintaining a clean home, and building healthy relationships, preparing young people for independent living.

Job placement and career counseling

We provide guidance and support in finding employment, including resume building, interview preparation and direct mediation with potential employers, to ensure participants achieve financial independence.

Mentorship and Specialized Courses

Offered mentorship with professionals in the young people's fields of interest and provided specialized courses to support their development.





Impact

Visible Progress

They show visible progress in their development, such as in communication, motivation, seriousness and responsibility.

Inspired by Shared Experiences

They are inspired by people who openly share their life experiences, such as trainers, guests and employers.

Continued Engagement

They have gained trust in the association members and continue to benefit from the association's support after leaving the program.

Household Management Skills

They have acquired knowledge related to managing a household and those who have completed the project have learned how to find a rental and manage on their own.



Impact

Increased Self-Confidence

Young people have gained more confidence in themselves, their plans, dreams and actions.

Improved Communication

They communicate better, more openly and non-violently, with the association, their friends and colleagues.

Appreciation for Practical and Personal Growth

They appreciate practical activities as well as deeper ones, through which they discover themselves.



2024 - Key achievements

- 246 Individual sessions of social assistance and psycho-emotional support.
- 221 psychological sessions provided emotional stability.
- 17 participants engaged in transformative activities.
- 22 workshops delivered skills for life and employment.
- 11 participants employed, reflecting resilience and adaptability.
- 56 sessions of vocational counseling and job market mediation.
- 65 sessions of educational counseling and financial education.


BOGDAN ŞTĂFĂNESCU

The next years offer an extraordinary opportunity to deepen our commitment to empowering vulnerable youth and to extend the transformative reach of the Life Plan program.

Our mission remains clear: to rebuild lives, restore dreams and create lasting change.

Through innovative strategies, collaborative partnerships, and a relentless focus on empowering young people, we aim to not only expand geographically but also enhance the depth of our impact.



Systemic change



Horizontal expansion (Geographical): Explore the possibility to replicate and scale the social housing component of the program across other regions or cities, ensuring adaptability to local contexts while maintaining program integrity.

Vertical expansion (Depth): Enhance the impact by building the capacity of DGASPC personnel, advocating for legal reforms, and collaborating with the Ministry of Social Affairs and Family to design a modern curriculum that integrates best practices in social assistance and child protection.

Community engagement



Experiential camps: Organize immersive camps that bring together volunteers and young participants (including potential new recruits and former participants) to foster community building, leadership development and shared learning experiences.


Dedicated mentorship program: Launch a structured corporate volunteering initiative (e.g., the "A FI Voluntar" program) that pairs professionals with young people for long-term mentorship, skill-building and career guidance, supporting their personal and professional growth.

Immersive experiences



The DREAMS INCUBATOR HUB: a community space dedicated to fostering innovation and collaboration among vulnerable youth, volunteers and partners, serving as a center for education, creativity and social interaction, while also offering a platform for partners to host workshops, training sessions and impactful events.

Social integration transition workplace: within the HUB, a 6-month training and employment experience. Through technical training, soft skills development and career counseling, the program equips participants with the confidence and tools to transition into long-term employment, supported by partnerships with hiring companies.
